

# **ERME Paper Award**

## A paper award; why?

- To value excellence in papers presented at CERME, particularly by young researchers
- To support excellent young researchers' career and publishing strategies

The paper awards have been designated since CERME12 (Bolzano).

## Who can be a candidate?

Eligible for the ERME paper award are young researchers. A young researcher is defined as a researcher, who has not finished a PhD in mathematics education more than three years before the the award is given (for CERME 14, you may not have a PhD from earlier than February 2022)

The basis for the award is the proposal submitted for the CERME at which the award is given.

#### How to be a candidate?

Papers may be proposed only if the first author is a young researchers, while any other authors need not be so. The proposal is to be done by the first author by Dec 10, 2024.

The award is only given to the first authors of the winning papers.

## Who will decide, and how?

The ERME board has elected a jury for the ERME paper award. The jury members will use a selection criteria framework for choosing three conference papers whose first authors will be awarded.

## For the winners

The three awardees will be honoured at the opening session of CERME14, where they are given the certificate for the ERME conference paper award.

The authors of the awarded conference papers also get the offer of support and training aiming to elaborate their conference papers into a (high ranked) journal paper.

The process of elaborating the paper will be supported by an experienced European researcher, namely one of the jury members or researchers recruited by the jury. The support includes:

- a) coaching of how to prepare a publication and how to select a journal,
- b) reviewing of the first draft of the paper.
- c) supporting awardee for revising the paper after the first (and further) reviews of the journal.

The guidelines for papers include the criteria for the ERME paper award. We strongly advise you to satisfy these criteria.
